This privacy policy sets out how The Rum Barrel uses and protects any information that you give when using this website or contacting us on social media. The Rum Barrel is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified using this website or our social media, you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement. The Rum Barrel may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes.

Data input: What we collect when you visit our website

You can visit our website without providing any personal data, exception of ensuring legal drinking age. We only record data in so-called server log-files, such as the name of the file accessed, the date and time of access. the data volume transferred and the requesting provider. This data will only be used to ensure proper functioning of the page and to improve our service, but cannot be traced back to you.

Data collection and use: What we do with the information we gather

We collect personal data when it is freely provided by you within the context of making contact with us. (e.g. via e-mail or subscription to our newsletter) The specific data gathered is that provided on the various information forms. We use the data provided by you for administration purposes and to process your queries.

Data: Disclosure and Security

Once we have received your personal data, we will use strict procedures and security features to prevent unauthorized access to it.

We keep your personal data for no longer than necessary for the purposes for which the personal data is processed. The length of time we retain personal data for depends on the purposes for which we collect and use it and/or as required to comply with applicable laws and to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights.

We do not sell your personal data to others and we never share your data unless obliged by applicable laws.

Data: How we use cookies

On many pages we use cookies in order to enhance the attractiveness of our website and to enable the proper utilization of certain functions. This incorporates the use of small text files which are stored on your device, that save specific settings and data regarding the exchange between your browser and our system. Some of the cookies used by us will be deleted at the end of your browser
